SELINSGROVE SPEEDWAY PRESENTS STOCK CAR SATURDAY NIGHT JUNE 25: SUPER LATE MODELS, LIMITED LATE MODELS, MID-ATLANTIC MODIFIEDS & PRO STOCKS IN THE C.W. SMITH MEMORIAL

SELINSGROVE, Pa. – Selinsgrove Speedway returns with another Stock Car Saturday Night racing program at 7:30 p.m. this Saturday, June 25, presented by the Sunbury Eagles Club. Track gates will open at 5 p.m.

On the card for the ninth race of the season will be the Selinsgrove Ford super late models, MAPCO Machine Shop limited late models, mid-Atlantic modifieds, and return of the pro stocks in the C.W. Smith Memorial.

The super late models will compete in a 25-lap feature paying \$3,000 to win. Six races to date have produced six different winners, with Gregg Satterlee of Rochester Mills picking up the most recent in the 24th Late Model Open last Saturday.

The limited late models will be back for the third time this season in a 20-lap feature paying \$1,200 to win. Andrew Yoder of Middleburg will be seeking the "three-peat" as he swept the events last Saturday, including his second feature win of the season, heat win, and a victory in the Lil' Bob's Dash for Cash.

Making their annual appearance at the track, the mid-Atlantic modifieds will race a 20-lap feature. Last year former NASCAR racer David Stremme scored the division's win at the track.

In the spotlight this Saturday will be the pro stocks in the division's first return to the track since Aug. 24, 2019, when Brandon Moser of Middleburg won the last race. The family of the late C.W. Smith of Williamsport has put together a memorial race to honor one of the speedway's former champions. The 28-lap tribute race will pay \$1,800 to win and \$225 to start out of the \$9,000 purse.

The pro stock division continues to run regularly at the Clinton County Speedway in Lock Haven. The C.W. Smith Memorial will run under the Clinton County technical rules that can be reviewed at clintoncountyspeedway.com/pro-stock.

C.W. Smith started his racing career at Selinsgrove in 1985 and won the 1987 limited late model track championship. He moved into the ARCA and Busch Series stock cars from 1994 through 2005. When he retired from driving, he continued as a car owner and crew chief for his son Jason's racing career from 2005 through 2016 in Selinsgrove's pro stock division. Together, they won the 2009 pro stock track championship. C.W. passed away in November of 2017 at the age of 70.
